Sunday March 29 at 4:05pm. All scouts receive a FREE P-Bruins hat and a 2008-2009 Scout Patch

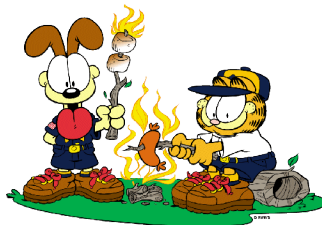
